ONE GREAT HOUR OF SHARING: is a multi-denominational offering that makes the love of Christ real for individuals and communities around the world who suffer the effects of disaster, conflict, or severe economic hardship, and for those who serve them through gifts of money and time. Today, projects are underway in more than 100 countries (including the United States). While specific allocations differ in each denomination, all use their One Great Hour of Sharing funds to make possible disaster relief, refugee assistance, development aid and more. On Sunday, June 27th, Appanoose Baptist Church will be taking a special "One Great Hour of Sharing" collection. The American Baptist Church designates the OGHs offerings for 1). Emergency relief available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for urgent or acute needs brought about by disasters of natural or human origin; 2). Development projects focused on meeting chronic human need by enabling individuals or groups to establish or maintain a more adequate quality of life; and 3). Refugee and immigration ministries focused on holistic ministry to immigrants, refugees, and migrants in detention facilities and refugee camps.
